



The cabin needs to be prepared for WINTER in about October

- Antifreeze: Use RV antifreeze in the RED container. It is more ecologically friendly and available at any Fred Meyer or hardware store.
- Turn off the water heater and drain it for winter.
- Turn off the water to the cabin at the main value under the kitchen window in the yard.
- Open the faucets inside the house to drain the lines.
- Antifreeze needs to go down the drains so the crook in the lines has antifreeze in them.
- Pour antifreeze in the toilet bowl and also in the back of the toilet. Any water left can freeze and crack the porcelain. Ruptured lines can leave water running in the cabin and do a lot of damage.

Help us maintain and respect this old family heirloom known as the Beehive Cabin.
